TRAINING FOR TEACHERS IN PALLIATIVE CARE: FOUNDATION COURSE

This well established and internationally renowned course provides training in contemporary teaching methods specifically for Health Care Professionals working in the field of palliative care.

If you are a Doctor or Healthcare Professional who has worked in palliative and end of life care for more than two years, have some experience in teaching and would like to develop this area of your practice, this course is suitable for you.

As the course often attracts an international audience, we offer a residential option which allows you to meet, socialise and network with colleagues and facilitators, sharing knowledge and experience beyond the classroom. Alternatively, you may wish to undertake the course through the non-residential option.

ABOUT THE COURSE

The Training for Teachers in Palliative Care Foundation Course is delivered over 3 consecutive days. The focus is on how to teach not what to teach, which enables you to examine adult educational theory and to explore the practical issue of how this can be applied in practice using a range of teaching methods and delivery skills. You will have the opportunity to gain an understanding of the impact of learning styles including the use of the KOLB educational model and how this can be adapted to enhance palliative care teaching.

During the course you will be encouraged to design and develop learner-centred education and explore how to adapt your teaching to meet the needs of various audiences.

Extending Your Learning

In addition to the Foundation Course, there is an option to extend your learning to complete a Masterclass in Training for Teachers in Palliative Care. This can be undertaken in combination with the Foundation Course, allowing you to extend your overall experience to 5 consecutive days.

HOW YOU WILL LEARN

Learning on this intensive, multidisciplinary course is participant centred and interactive. You will be involved in a variety of activities during the 3 days, including seminars led by international expert speakers and interactive group learning facilitated by clinically based palliative care specialists. The course provides lots of opportunity for you to reflect upon your current practice and develop new knowledge and skills.



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ASSESSMENT

As a participant on the course you will be asked to undertake a number of learning activities. This will include individual and group presentations, which aim to enable you to practice specific skills and to receive feedback from your facilitators and peers. On completion of the course you will receive a 'Training for Teachers in Palliative Care Foundation Course' Certificate.

This course has received Royal College of Physicians CPD event approval.
